The Lindbergh Award ~ Annually, for the past 25 years, the Foundation has presented its honorary Lindbergh Award for significant contributions toward a balance between technology and nature.

Lindbergh Grants ~ Each year, grants are made in support of research and public education projects that further the concept of balance. More than 230 men and women in the U.S. and abroad have received more than \$2 million since the Lindbergh Grants program began.

Educational Programs and Publications ~ The Foundation sponsors publications, prizes and other events advancing the Lindberghs' balance vision.

The Charles A. and Anne Morrow Lindbergh Foundation is a public 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, based in Minnesota, not far from Lindbergh's boyhood home, and is supported by contributions from individuals, companies, and foundations nationwide.
